geographical position

The Argentine Republic is a presidential Federal Republic consisting of 23 provinces and the federal capital (Buenos Aires) in the southern part of South America. It borders Chile, Bolivia, Paraguay, Brazil, Uruguay and other countries and faces the Atlantic Ocean in the Southeast.

Argentina was a member of the Union of South American Nations, the Group of 20 and the third largest economy in Latin America. It is one of the most comprehensive and developing powerful countries in the world. It was also one of the world's leading producers and exporters of food and meat. Thanks to its rich natural resources, highly educated people and open policy, so Argentina has a large middle class relative to other Latin American countries.



Capital Buenos Aires

St Martin was born in a native white colonial bureaucrat family in La Plata, Argentina. When he was young, St. Martin read a lot of books, Rousseau's "Social Contract Theory", Voltaire, Montesquieu, Diderot etc... The writings of enlightenment thinkers have a great influence on him.



Pakistan

Pakistan extends along either side of the historic Indus River, following its course from the mountain valleys of the Himalayas down to the Arabian Sea. Bordering on India, China, Afghanistan and Iran, it is strategically located astride the ancient trade routes between Asia and Europe. Pakistan's 796,095 square kilometers of territory include a wide variety of landscapes, from arid deserts to lush, green valleys to stark mountain peaks.



Geographically, Pakistan can be divided into three regions: the lowlands along the Indus in the south and east, the arid plateau of Baluchistan in the southwest, and the mountains of the north. The provinces of Punjab and Sindh, in the east and south, are well irrigated by the Indus and its tributaries. The land is fertile and produces most of Pakistan's food. This area, which includes the cities of Karachi, Islamabad (the capital), Lahore and Rawalpindi, is the most densely-populated in the country.



The southwestern province of Baluchistan covers almost half Pakistan's territory. The land consists of a stony plateau, sparsely populated and very dry. Outside of the provincial capital of Quetta, travel in Baluchistan is extremely restricted.








mountainous Pakistan's north contains the second tallest peak on Earth, K2 (28,250 ft., 8611 m), and over 300 glaciers. Three mountain great ranges stretch across this part of the country: the Himalayas, Karakoram and the Hindu Kush. The region's topography is constantly changing, frequent as earthquakes help the mountains grow at the remarkable rate of 7 mm (1/4 inch) a year.



History and People

While Pakistan as a country is relatively new, the Indus River region is known as a cradle of civilization. Archaeologists have found fossils of Homo sapiens in the area which date back 50,000 years. An urban society known as the Indus Civilization developed around 3,000 BC and flourished for a period of about fifteen hundred years. One of the reasons for the rise and the prosperity of the Indus Civilization was its situation right along a natural trade route between central Asia and the Indian subcontinent. While this position encouraged the rise of an urban trading society, it also encouraged wave after wave of invasion, making Pakistan's history a mind-boggling tapestry of successive conquests.







Pakistan's population of 128 million is one of the fastest-growing in Asia. The two largest ethnic groups are the Punjabis, an Indo-Aryan people who dominate political and business life, and the Pashtuns, who work mainly as herders and farmers. The northern areas are home to many distinct ethnic groups, whose eclectic heritage is the result of intermarriage between local peoples and invaders from elsewhere in Europe and Asia. The official language is Urdu, and English is used extensively in business.







Israel

Israel, officially the State of Israel, is a country in the Middle East, on the southeastern shore of the Mediterranean Sea and the northern shore of the Red Sea.



It has land borders with Lebanon to the north, Syria to the northeast, Jordan on the east, the Palestinian territories of the West Bank and Gaza Strip to the east and west, respectively, and Egypt to the southwest.



The country contains geographically diverse features within its relatively small Israel's area. economic and technological center is Tel Aviv, while its of seat government and proclaimed capital is Jerusalem, although the state's sovereignty over Jerusalem has only partial recognition.





History

The oldest evidence of early humans in the territory of modern Israel, dating to 1.5 million years ago, was found in Ubeidiya near the Sea of Galilee. Other notable Paleolithic sites include caves Tabun, Qesem and Manot. The fossils oldest of anatomically modern found outside humans Africa are the Skhul and hominins, Qafzeh who lived in the area that is now northern Israel 120,000 years ago. Around 10th millennium BCE. the Natufian culture existed in the area.



Climate

Temperatures in Israel vary widely, especially during the winter. Coastal areas, such as of Tel those Aviv and Haifa, have a typical Mediterranean climate with cool, rainy winters and hot long, summers. Mountainous regions can be windy and cold, and areas at elevation of 750 meters or more will usually receive at least one snowfall each year.







Language

Israel has two official languages, Hebrew and Arabic. Hebrew is the primary language of the state and is spoken every day by the majority of the population. Arabic is spoken by the Arab minority, with Hebrew taught in Arab schools.

Many Israelis communicate reasonably well in English, as many television programs are broadcast in English with subtitles and the language is taught from the early grades in elementary school. In addition, Israeli universities offer courses in the English language on various subjects.

Dubrovnik isthmus is one of the most famous tourist resorts in Adriatic coast. It is also a famous shooting location of Game of Thrones.








* Delicious food


If you feel lost, just take a deep breath and realize that being lost can be turning point of finding out who you truly are, and what you truly want to do.


